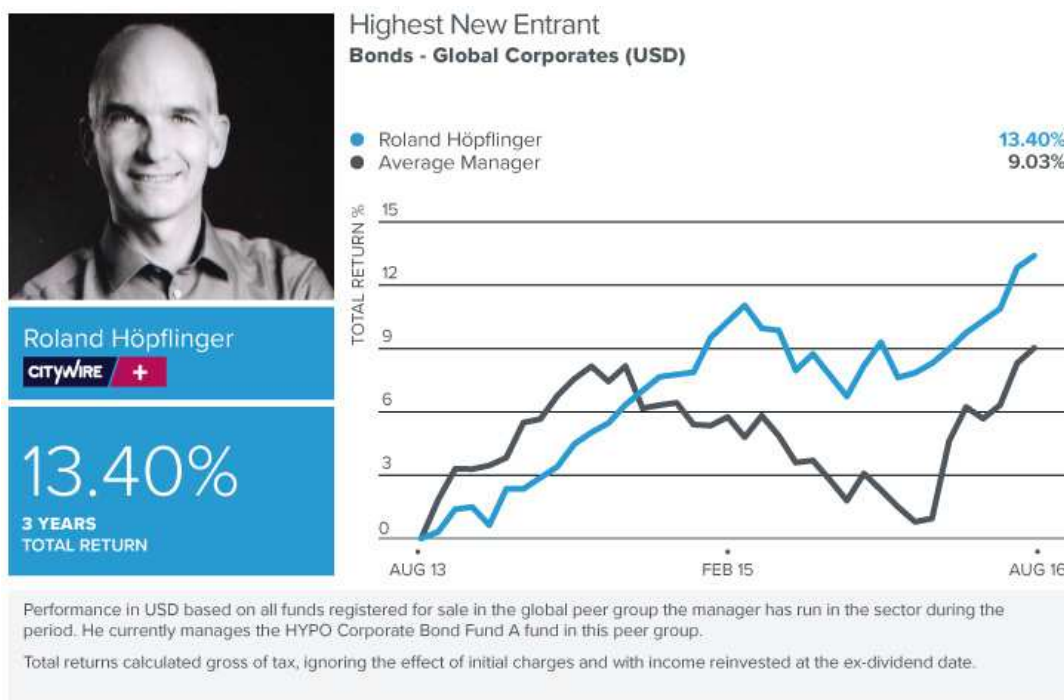


The newly-rated corporate bond managers to watch

Overview

Masterinvest's [Roland Höpflinger](#) makes his debut this month with a Citywire + rating, which is based on his strong, three-year, risk-adjusted performance. Höpflinger has been the lead manager on the [HYPO Corporate Bond Fund](#) since April 2012.

This Austria-domiciled fund aims to achieve a longer-term capital appreciation at medium volatility. Over 50% of its assets are in corporate bonds, while the rest is from global government bonds or other bonds, money market instruments or deposits. Over the past three years, Höpflinger has outperformed the average manager, returning 13.40% against a peer return of 9.03% in US dollar terms.
